Provided always And I further declare that the said several trustees hereby appointed and to be appointed as aforesaid and each and every of them and the heirs executors administrators and assigns of them and each and every of them shall be charged and chargeable respectively for such amount only as they respectively shall actually receive by virtue of the trusts hereby in them expressed notwithstanding their or any of their giving or signing or joining in giving or signing any receipt or receipts for the said or responsibility and any one or more of them shall not be answerable or accountable to the other or others of them or for involuntary losses nor for the loss by the failure of the securities hereinafter provided to be given And also that it shall and may be lawful for them with and out of the moneys which shall come to their respective hands by virtue of the trusts aforesaid to retain to and reimburse themselves respectively and also to allow their respective retainers or retainers all costs charges damages and expenses which they or any of them shall or may suffer sustain sustain or incur or be put into in or about the execution of the aforesaid trusts or in relation therunto And I hereby revoke and make void all former Wills and Testaments by me at any time heretofore made and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in writing whereof I have to this my Will contained in four sheets of Paper set my hand this eighth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty - John Firmin - signed by the said John Firmin in the presence of us present at the same time who in this presence have subscribed our names as Witnesses the words "I give in Pledge and Bridge Rotherhithe in the County of Surrey" on the eighth line and under the fourth line of the first sheet and the words "the survivors of the said four" on the fourth line of the second sheet having been first written over erased and the sentence beginning "and" and ending "alive" between the eighth and ninth lines of the third sheet having been first inserted together with the erasures in the fourth and fifth lines of this sheet - The Young 29 Mark Lane - Edw. C. Bench his Clerk.

Proved at London the 14<sup>th</sup> Dec: 1850 before the Worshipful Vicar Thomas Pratt Doctor of Laws and Surrogate by the Oath of Henry Firmin the son one of the Executors to whom London was granted having been sworn duly to administer. Power reserved of making the like Oath to Sarah Firmin Widow the Decit and William Boyer the other Executors when they shall apply for the same.

Some in the County of Kent Civil Engineer First I direct all my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses (except a debt of five hundred pounds charged upon my freehold estate at Cople. le. some aforesaid) to be paid and satisfied out of my personal estate And I give and bequeath all my books and instruments unto the Reverend John Ashmole Buggs of Brixels Green near Sevenoaks in the said County of Kent And I give and devise all that my messuage or tenement now or heretofore in three tenements and known by the name of the "White House" together with the outhouses buildings gardens laws or ground and hereditaments thereto adjoining and belonging situate at Cople. le. some aforesaid

and now in my own occupation unto my two friends John Dighton and  
 in the said County of West Gloucestershire the Reverend John Briggs the  
 elder of Devonshire aforesaid Distanting Minister To hold the same unto  
 them the said John Dighton and John Briggs their heirs and assigns  
 Upon trust to receive the rents issues and profits thereof and thereout to pay  
 an Annuity or yearly sum of twenty pounds sterling unto my loving wife  
 Esther Graven such Annuity to be paid to her by quarterly instalments and the first  
 instalment of six to be paid to her within six months after my decease and  
 subject thereto I direct my said trustees after payment of the expenses of keep-  
 ing the said premises in repair and insured against fire to pay the said rents  
 interest and annual profits unto my wife Priscilla Sawyer Sorbham and her  
 assigns during the term of her life and from and immediately after the decease  
 of my said wife I direct my said trustees or the survivor of them his or  
 their executors administrators or assigns To convey and assure the said  
 messuage or tenement buildings gardens lands and hereditaments unto my  
 wife Mary Jagger now or late of Knight Street Liverpool and to her or  
 heirs and assigns absolutely subject nevertheless to and chargeable with the  
 payment of the said sum of five hundred pounds secured thereon and also  
 to the payment of the said Annuity of twenty pounds unto the said Esther  
 Graven during her life. All as to all the rest residue and remainder  
 of my real and personal Estate whatsoever and wheresoever and whether  
 in England or America I give devise and bequeath the same unto my said  
 wife Priscilla Sawyer Sorbham her heirs executors administrators and  
 assigns absolutely for her and their own use and benefit And lastly I give  
 and devise all such real estates as may be vested in me upon any trust or  
 by way of mortgage unto the said John Dighton and John Briggs their  
 heirs and assigns To hold the same unto the said John Dighton and John  
 Briggs their heirs and assigns Upon such trusts as may be from time to time  
 subsisting containing the same but the money secured upon any such  
 mortgages I declare shall be received and taken as part of my personal  
 estate And I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said wife and the  
 said John Dighton and John Briggs joint Executors and Executor of this my  
 Will In witness whereof I the said Elias Pym Sorbham have to each  
 part of this my last Will and Testament in two sheets of paper containing  
 six my hand this eighth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 eight hundred and fifty — Elias Pym Sorbham — signed by the said  
 Testator as and for his last Will and Testament in the simultaneous presence  
 of us who in his presence at his request and in the presence of each other  
 have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses — G. W. Graven solicitor  
 Dover — Peter Holden Surgeon Folkestone.

Proved at London the 14<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1850 before the Judge by the Oaths  
 of John Dighton and the Reverend John Briggs the Elder two of the Execu-  
 tors to whom Power was granted having been first sworn by Oath or duly  
 to administer. Power reserved of making the like Oath to Priscilla  
 Sawyer Sorbham widow the said the other Executor when she shall  
 apply for the same.
